


JOB SUMMARY:

Under general supervision, performs a variety of routine and general grounds maintenance duties and task including irrigation system tasks throughout the PRTC facilities and associated areas.

JOB FUNCTIONS:

Maintains exterior landscape of facility including houses, tennis courts, fields, medians and training 30% environment. Performs routine landscape maintenance including irrigation, mowing, and pruning, trimming of trees, hedges 30% and bushes. Apply chemical substances to control weeds and undesirable plants/insects as well as encouraging/promoting healthy growth of lawns, trees, shrubs and flowers. 5% Plants new and replacement landscape materials to enhance exterior environment. 5% Performs routine repair and maintenance of equipment; installs, maintains and replaces automatic and manual water and irrigation systems. 5% Removes trash from building and grounds; picks up litter; sweep and removes ice and snow from campus walkways, applies ice melt when indicated. 5% Prepares Playas site areas for special events. 5% Completes all beautification projects in accordance with indication requests. 5% Implements detailed landscape plans. 5% Required to Operate a University vehicle in the day to day operations and perform other duties as assigned. 5%
