



## Financial Aid/Scholarship Appeal Form

Students have the opportunity to appeal the loss of Federal and State Financial Aid (grants, work study, student loans, parent loans) and/or the loss of scholarships if the student feels they had unusual circumstances, such as a serious illness or a death in the family that affected their academic performance. To appeal, the student needs to complete and submit this form to the Financial Aid Office. Supporting documentation may be requested.
