

STARTING RATE or SALARY RANGE: \$15.25

Employees being promoted to a higher classified position receive the minimum for the position or a pay rate adjustment of 8% whichever is greater.

JOB DUTIES:

The fundamental purpose of this position is to perform carpentry duties to build, repair, or fabricate fixtures/ structures/ apparatuses to ensure safe and efficient testing and maintenance in support of RDT&E and training programs conducted by EMRTC at the New Mexico Tech Socorro, and Playas sites. This position is critical to the organization in that it is designed to develop an experienced and seasoned craftsman capable of assuming full carpentry responsibilities in support of the carpentry team and independently to meet the goals and needs of EMRTC and its customers. The skills and knowledge required for this position are elementary and serve only as a starting point. This position is designed to provide opportunity for personal growth, broadened skills, and career advancement.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

High school (or GED) level ability in spelling, grammar, basic composition and math. Two (2) years' experience in general construction, framing, finishing, trim, and installation required; however equivalent experience in general test range work will be considered. Must be able to use all power and hand tools effectively and safely required. Overall knowledge of trades and construction desired. Certified or the ability to certify, within a reasonable amount of time, on relevant light/medium equipment required. A valid NM Driver's License required. A pre- employment drug screen required upon hire.
