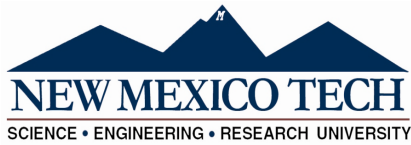

Diagnose and correct equipment malfunctions and mechanical adjustments to maintain or restore equipment. Heavy equipment operator.

JOB DUTIES:

Drive any and all equipment assigned for the range to include but not limited to: HMMWV, Skid Steer, Backhoe, Grader, Front End Loader, Farm Equipment, or other various equipment needed to support range operation. Repair target pits, or other areas. Maintain roads. Operate computer. Performs Mechanical adjustments to maintain or restore equipment. May operate a motor vehicle to transport materials and equipment, as appropriate to the position. Performs miscellaneous job-related duties as assigned
