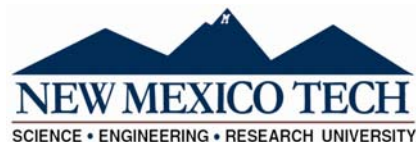

JOB DUTIES:
