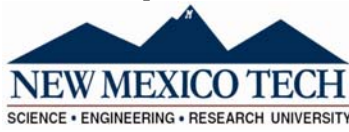

## English Composition Instructor

The CLASS Department is looking for a full-time English instructor to teach four classes per semester in our First-Year Writing Sequence (English 111, English 112, and/or English 341), with occasional opportunities to teach humanities courses in their area of specialty. The lecturer would be responsible for delivering lessons, commenting on and grading student work, and conferencing with students. The instructor will also participate in informal writing program meetings to discuss pedagogical techniques, lesson planning, and grading strategies.

Candidates should have an MA or MFA in English or a related field and teaching experience. Preference will be given to candidates with expertise and experience teaching STEM students.
