JOB DUTIES:

Install and maintains campus data network equipment including core and edge devices. Also supports some router/layer 3 configuration. Involved in the installation and maintenance of application servers and/or services. This position is responsible for providing network support to administrative and academic network users with a variety of physical/virtual software, hardware, security, and network services. Also supports network printers, scanners, IP telephones and other devices. Supports the configuration, installation, monitoring and operation of the wireless infrastructure. Supervises full time staff as well as student workers.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

Must be able to read and comprehend instructions, have good writing skills and complete simple forms. High School (or GED) level ability in spelling, grammar, basic composition and math. Associates degree (or greater) or completion of program of 18+ months after high school. Area of study: IT, Computer Science or related field. Two years of applicable experience may be substituted for the education requirement.

Two years experience with the installation and maintenance of TCP/ IP network and data systems –OR– Two years experience as a system administrator utilizing Windows 2003 (or above) operating systems –OR– Two years experience as a system administrator utilizing UNIX/ Linux operating systems required. Must be able to work as part of a team effectively.
