

### JOB DUTIES:

Must have thorough knowledge of various plumbing and mechanical systems including water, sewer, gas, air and vacuum equipment and distribution and instruct subordinates on proper maintenance, repair and replacement of such systems. Interfaces regularly local utility providers as required to coordinate repair, replacement and new work projects, and closely monitors the work of outside contractors to ensure work is done according to design/ code specifications and expectation of New Mexico Tech.
