Satellite Accumulation Area (SAA)

This area has been designated as a Satellite Accumulation Area

- There may be no more than 55 gallons of hazardous waste (or 1 liter of acutely hazardous waste) at this SAA at any one time.
 - If there is, the Lab Manager/PI must contact Research Compliance at (<u>hazmat@nmt.edu</u>) who must relocate the waste to the Central Accumulation Area (CAA) within exactly three days.

> All waste must be labeled upon generation.

- Use Hazardous Waste Labels provided by Research Compliance. Make sure to add chemical names (<u>NO</u> <u>CHEMICAL FORMULAS</u>) and concentrations.
- The label must provide an indication of the type(s) of hazards of the waste (e.g. Corrosive, Flammable, Toxic, etc.).
- Add initial date of waste generation under "Satellite
 - Accumulation Area Start Date".
- DO NOT add a date to the "Central Accumulation Area Start Date". Research Compliance will fill this out when the waste is transported to the CAA.
- Store incompatible wastes separately.
- > Keep lids securely on containers when not actively adding waste.
- > Ensure that waste containers are undamaged and in good condition.

Remember the Three "C" s of Satellite Accumulation Areas: Condition, Closed, and Compatible!
